The risk of postoperative visual loss is increased in patients undergoing prone spinal surgery. Pregabalin and gabapentin may reduce both perioperative and chronic pain after spinal surgery. The type of surgery performed on the spine encompasses operations for trauma, deformity, and myelopathy.

Indications for spinal anesthesia include lower abdominal, perineal, and LE surgery. Technically one could use it for upper abdominal surgery however because these procedures impact breathing so profoundly, general anesthesia is generally preferred.

In at least one study, patients with a history of spine surgery but without radicular features, peripheral neuropathy, or motor deficits had a similar risk of complications from neuraxial anesthesia as patients who had not undergone spine surgery [5, 13]. A full preoperative history and neurologic exam is prudent in any patient with prior spine ...

### Neuraxial anesthesia following spine procedures ...

Perioperative visual loss (POVL) associated with spine surgery is a rare and disastrous complication that is generally irreversible and without definitive etiology. First described by Hollenhorst et al in 1954, there have been numerous reports since establishing a clear link between spine surgery in the prone position and vision loss.

NEURAXIAL ANESTHESIA FOR PATIENTS WITH PREVIOUS SPINAL SURGERY Prior spinal surgery, including surgical correction of scoliosis is not a contraindication to neuraxial anesthesia. There are, however, additional challenges to neuraxial anesthesia techniques after prior spinal surgery due to the anatomic changes.

The increased complexity of spinal surgical procedures in recent years has required more sophisticated anesthetic management of patients undergoing these procedures. Spine surgery anesthesia is now recognized as a distinct sub-specialty, increasingly undertaken by general anesthesiologists as well as neuroanesthesiologists.
