73 Epidermolysis bullosa (EB) is a clinically and genetically heterogeneous group of inherited disorders that are characterized by blistering of the skin and certain other tissues. Caused by

mutations in COL7A1, affecting the structure of type VII collagen. Type VII collagen forms delicate fibrils that anchor the basal lamina to collagen fibrils in the dermis. These anchoring fibrils are reduced in this form of the disease, causing friction and blistering.

Collagen XVI, by structural analogy a member of the FACIT- (fibril-associated collagens with interrupted triple helices) family of collagens, is described as a

minor collagen component of connective tissues. Collagen XVI is expressed in various cells and tissues without known occurrence of splice variants or isoforms.
